Sermon Outline

<u>Focus:</u> The good news of Jesus is that we don't travel alone in the journey through life. The Holy Spirit comes alongside with power and guidance through the fellowship of believers

I) A chapel in a penal colony in Port Arthur, Tasmania

50 mini cubicles where the prisoners could not see or communicate with one another No possibility to experience the Good News of the "one another" way

II) Acts 2: The power of the Holy Spirit bringing diverse people together

Aftermath of Peter sharing the Good News of Jesus

Every different class, ethnicity, and age were present

The catalyst was not the eloquent preaching but the presence of the Holy Spirit

III) Seven Characteristics of the Spirit filled Church

Wonder (v.43) Awe came upon everyone

Detecting the PING moments (Power In Noticing God)

Miracles (v.43) many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles.

We don't see miracles until you pray and believe in supernatural power

Fellowship (v.44) All who believed were together

Living out the "one another" way: love, forgive, accept, teach, comfort, serve

Generosity (v.45) they would sell their possessions and goods and distribute the proceeds to all, as any had need

Worship (v.46) *Day by day, as they spent much time together in the temple...praising God*Offering praise heals, restores, renews, revives and empowers

Good Reputation (v.47) having the goodwill of all the people

No need for guilt trips as no one could stop people from gathering

Growth (v.47) day by day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved. In the span of a fifty years, spread throughout the empire

IV) The blessings of A Holy Spirit filled community
