

Sermon Outline

<u>Focus:</u> The first of the signs of Jesus is supplying the source of abiding joy for a wedding feast. In a world that is often searching for joy in all the wrong places, Jesus reminds us that when we do whatever he tells us, we experience real glory.

I) "Jesus Lord at thy Birth" The Good News according to John's Gospel

First **Message** of Hope: "In him was life and the life was the light of all people" (1:4)

First Question that all need to answer "What are you looking for?" (1:38)

First **Sign** of his purpose "Jesus did this the first of his signs and revealed his glory" (2:11)

II) A Wedding Faux Pas

Guests should never wear white to a wedding: Upstaging the Bride

In Jewish culture, running out of wine is a shameful faux pas

III) Turning Water into Wine (John 2:1-12)

Not feeding the multitudes, nor healing the sick but providing gallons of wedding wine!

The Jesus way is **not** fun sucking but joy giving!

C. S Lewis: "Joy is the serious business of heaven."

Mary's reaction to a social disaster: "Do whatever he tells you." (v. 5)

The Servants obeyed and offered a witness to the Glory of the Lord (v. 9)

Transforming six water jugs for purification into vessels of life giving joy In the midst of challenging situations, the Lord has different plans

IV) Where have you been searching for Joy?

A store? A bottle? A pill?

What happens when a marriage dissolves, a disease expands, or a dream dies?

V) Jesus followers can drink with joy because he drank the cup of wrath that we deserve

"My hour has not yet come" (v. 4): Reference to his time to die

For Christians, joy is found in a feast involving bread and wine, signs of what is coming "unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you." (6:53)

This month try sharing the Good News by inviting someone to church during the advent or Christmas season.
