

Sermon Outline

<u>Focus:</u> In Matthew 11, we see John the Baptist grapple with doubt as he asks, "Jesus, are you the One?" We each have situations in our lives that cause us to doubt, but through this passage, we learn that Jesus exceeds all of our expectations.

I. Matthew 11:2-6

Frank Reich - 1993 Buffalo Bills playoff game Jesus – the hero we didn't expect <u>but</u> the one we needed What can we learn in this passage?

1. Doubts are normal in difficult seasons

Jesus wasn't meeting John's expectations

Jesus responds not with rebuke, but with reassurance

Doubt isn't the opposite of faith – despair is

Doubt is like weightlifting – building strength when we press into God

2. Jesus redefines our expectations

Jesus points to Isaiah 35 and 61 – his fulfillment of prophecy

Jesus' mission was to restore what was broken

The Kingdom of NOW and NOT YET

Jesus doesn't always meet our expectations – he exceeds them

3. The offense of Jesus' mission

"And blessed is the one who is not offended by me." (v. 6)

Jesus addresses our deepest need – reconciliation with God

2 Kings 5 - Naaman

The scandal of grace is also our hope

4. The call to trust Jesus

Learning to swim: "Trust me, jump!"

Our doubts don't disqualify us from His love

"Jesus, are you the One?" – what are you facing today that makes you ask that?

Charles Spurgeon - "God is too good to be unkind, and He is too wise to be mistaken. And when we cannot trace His hand, we must trust His heart."

Sermon Outline

Focus: Jesus did not fit John's dreams and over time the Baptizer began to doubt the plans of the Lord. Sometimes our dreams are too small for God's amazing plan. Like John, we want a God who conforms to our desires rather than allowing ourselves to be conformed to God's desire.

I) Losing everything in California Wildfires

William Gonzales "The flames have consumed all our dreams."

II) John the Baptist's dreams for the Messiah (Matthew 3)

One who cuts down rather than plants (v. 10) One who burns rather than builds (v. 12)

One confirmed with a heavenly voice (v. 17)

III) What has happened to John in Prison? (Matthew 11)

Doubtful "Are you the one who is to come, or are we to wait for another?" (v. 3)

Before: "Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29)

There is no sin in doubt!

Buechner: Doubts are the ants in the pants of faith. They keep it awake and moving."

Jesus responds with signs to 'prove' he is the One chosen by God

Reference to Isaiah 35:4-5

Signs and Wonders for those with eyes to see and ears to hear!

The Challenge that Jesus offers to all who follow

"Blessed is anyone who takes no offense at me." (v. 6)

Jesus is offensive to "religion" which believes you can earn your own salvation

IV) Embracing new vantage points when dreams go unfulfilled and doubts linger

The journey, not the destination, is the main event: Pay attention to the path Re-examine open doors that were previously ignored: Did we miss something?

No promise that life would be easy: Yet nothing separates us from His Love
