

Sermon Outline

<u>Focus:</u> In Mark 9 when we read about the transfiguration of Jesus, we see that Jesus revealed a glimpse of his glory to his disciples. We are not meant to stay in our "mountain top moments," but to trust Jesus completely and carry his glory into the ordinary moments of life as well.

- I. Mark 9:2-9 Transfiguration of Jesus
 Powerful, mountain-top moments
 Drew Brees and his son, Braylen Super Bowl victory
 Peter: "Let's build shelters and stay here forever!"
- II. Jesus shows us his glory, so that we can trust Him completely (Mark 9:2-4)

 Jesus gives Peter, James and John a glimpse of his glory, for they will soon face trials

 The power of perspective perspectives from space and the beauty of creation

 When life gets hard, we don't need better circumstances; we need perspective

 Are you seeing Jesus for who He truly is, or are you shrinking Him down?
- III. Jesus calls us to listen to Him, and not just experience Him (Mark 9:5-7)

 Experiencing Jesus' glory isn't the only goal listening to Him is

 Are we obeying Jesus in the ordinary moments, not just the spiritual highs?

 Where is Jesus speaking in your life right now, and are you listening?
- IV. Jesus calls us down the mountain to live in His glory daily (Mark 9:8-9)

Sermon Outline

<u>Focus:</u> In Mark 9 Jesus revealed a glimpse of his glory to his disciples in the Transfiguration. We are not meant to stay in our "mountain top moments," but to listen and trust Jesus completely into the ordinary moments of life.

- I) Basking in the glory of Bubble Rock on October 17th
 Just want to stay in the moment
- II) What is the point of the Transfiguration on the Mountain? (9:2-9)

 For Jesus: A blessing to prepare for his upcoming mission of going to the cross

 For the Disciples: An affirmation that Jesus is the source of glory, not just the **reflection**

In that moment, the disciples are offered a foretaste of the Glory divine

The Son is the radiance of God's glory and exact representation (Exodus 34)

III) The Role of Worship

Focusing on a fixed reference in a disoriented world

Finding equilibrium by remembering to whom I belong

Praise is "inner health made audible" Lewis

Generous and happy people are prone to praise, while others complain

The limits of wanting to build tents to hold the glory (v.5)

In our desire to confine God's glory, we miss the joy of the moment
