Jesus is not "one of many" paths to God – he is THE way

Acts 4:12 "Salvation is found in no one else..."

This is personal – not a self-improvement plan, but a relationship with a person John 10:9 "I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved."

III. Jesus is the Truth – The foundation of life

Truth is absolute

I) Future Fears

So much anxiety, so little awe

Staring into a casket and seeking trust

II) Preparing the Disciples for what is to come: the Farewell Discourse (John 14)

"Do not let your hearts be troubled" "believe also in me." "you know the way"

The persecution of Diocletian

Thomas speaks for many of us... "We don't know where you are going"

III) Jesus is the Way- "There is salvation in no one else," Acts 4:12

Jesus is not "one of many" paths to God – he is THE way

The Jesus Way is never the path of least resistance....involves challenge Leads to a personal relationship not a self-help plan.

IV) Jesus is the Truth - The foundation of life

Truth is not an opinion, it's the very embodiment of the Word of God (John 1:14)

Jesus doesn't point to the truth: He is the truth.

V) Jesus is the Life – The source of Eternal and Abundant Life

Eternal life starts now! *I came that they may have life and have it abundantly* John 10:10 Without Jesus, we are spiritually dead! *apart from me you can do nothing* John 15:5

VI) The controversy generated by John 14:6 in a world that demands inclusivity

Oprah "One of the biggest mistakes people make is to believe that there's only one way." The beauty and power of believing that Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life Newbigin "We can go forward with confidence because Jesus has gone that way before us and has come back from the deep valley. If he is himself the track, we can go forward confidently when the future is hidden. We are not lost. We have a reliable track."

Trusting in the Jesus way doesn't make us arrogant, it makes us graciously humble
