

Sermon Outline

<u>Focus:</u> Jesus enters the paths of death and grief to show us the way towards abundant and eternal life. When we walk in faith, we discover the way to a significant existence.

I) Have the "dire wolves" come back to life?

Colossal CEO "we took DNA from an (ancient tooth) and made ...dire wolf puppies." Lynch "All you can do now is make something look superficially like something else"

II) The resurrection of Lazarus (John 11)

Anticipation of what is to come (v. 14-15)

"I am the resurrection and the life." (v. 25)

The meaning of anastasis "standing up again"

Not just on the last day... each day

Taking advantage of a new lease on life

The power of belief: Leads to new life (v. 26-27)

III) Trading Places with Lazarus

Lazarus left the tomb, but the price was that Jesus had to enter it (v. 45-48) Taylor: "Jesus traded his life for Lazarus' life, among others, by doing with his friend what God was about to do with him."

IV) The Good news of Jesus being Resurrection and Life

Sermon Outline

<u>Focus:</u> In the gospel of John, we read that Jesus is the resurrection and the life. This is not only true for our future, but for us TODAY as we step out of our spiritual tombs and step into something new in Christ.

I. I AM...Resurrection and Life

II. Jesus is the Resurrection – victory over death

Mary and Mary – resurrection as a future event

1 Corinthians 15:55: "Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?"

The Early Church – Courage in the face of death

Easter means that no grave can hold us because no grave could hold Jesus!

III. Jesus is the Life – the power to live today

John 10:10 – "I have come that they may have life and have it to the full."

2 Corinthians 5:17 – "If anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

Easter is also about Jesus bringing us out of our tombs – addiction, depression, sin, and hopelessness – Jesus conquered death for both himself AND us!

What spiritual tomb are you walking around in?

IV. The invitation – will you walk out?

John 5:24 "...whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life."

Many people choose to stay in the grave – we are invited to step out every single day Tori Hope Petersen – stepping into something new

V. Jesus to Martha – "Do you believe this?"
